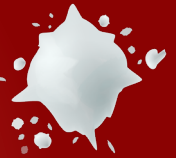




# CHRISTMAS ACTIVITY PACK



## HOW TO MAKE MAGIC REINDEER DUST

### What you will need:

- Oats
- Glitter
- Small clear bag or food bag (Ziplok Bags work really well)
- Ribbon

### Make the Reindeer Food

Mix 1/2 cup of oatmeal (quick oats work best) with your favourite colour glitter sprinkles so the reindeer food sparkles for Santa's Reindeer to find! Stir around to mix everything together.

### Pack the reindeer dust

Pour the mixture into a bag. Tie off the bag with colourful ribbon adding the tag or you could staple the printable Reindeer Dust tag to the top of the bag.

### On Christmas Eve...

Sprinkle the mixture on the front lawn as a special treat for Santa's Reindeer. The reindeer will see the sprinkles glittering on the lawn to find your house and enjoy their treat while Santa leaves presents inside and finds his own milk and cookies!
